

# Overnight Trip to Luxor from Aswan Visit Kom Omo Temple, Edfu and Luxor Top Attractions

## DAY 1:

As per requested time Emo Tours expert Tour guide will pick you up from your hotel in Aswan to enjoy a day tour to the Temple of Kom Ombo standing on high grounds overlooking the Nile.

It differs from other temples because of its double entrance, each one is dedicated to divinity: "Haroeris" with his falcon head and " Sobek " with his crocodile head. The Temple of Kom Ombo was built on the honor of two deities the crocodile-headed Sobek, god of fertility and creator of the world, and Haroeris or the ancient falcon-headed Horus, Lunch box included.

Then transferred to Edfu by road to visit the majestic temple dedicated to Horus which is considered by most to be the best preserved cult temple in Egypt. According to the Egyptian myths, it was the place where the falcon-headed god Horus revenged the murder of his father Osiris by killing Seth Arrival Luxor then Start your Tour Visiting Karnak Temple the greatest example of worship in the history, dedicated to the God Amon, his wife Mut and their son Khonsu Spend around 3 hours there then Transfer you to Lotus Nile Hotel For Check in and take some rest before Starting your Night Visit to Luxor Temple

As per requested time Pickup from your Hotel by Our Expert Tour guide to start your evening visit to Luxor Temple, it was built by Amunhotep III in 18th Dynasty in the New Kingdom and it was completed by Ramesses II during the 19th Dynasty. Later you will be driven back to your hotel in Luxor overnight in Luxor.

## DAY 2:

Breakfast at the hotel as per requested time Pickup from your hotel by our expert tour guide to start your day tour visiting the West Bank where you will visit the Valley Of The Kings, the magnificence of the grandeur of architecture which was used for burial, there are many kings buried in this valley. The most known tombs are King Tutmosis I, Tutmosis III, Tut-Ankh-Amon, King Ramsess VI, King Mrenptah and Amonhotep II. Followed by a visit to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut that known as El Dir El Bahari which was built by Queen Hatshepsut the daughter of Thutmosis I, who ruled Egypt about 20 years during the 18th Dynasty (approximately 1490-1469 B.C), the only pharaonic woman who reigned ancient Egypt. Then continue your day Tour to The Colossi of Memnon which are remains of the mortuary temple of Amenhotep III around 12: afternoon transfer you to Luxor Airport End of Our Services
